1. Participation in Sree Narayana International Award Ceremony at Press Club, Tvm

2. Visit to Kumaran Asan National Institute of Culture, Thonakkal

The Sree Narayana Study Centre in association with Malayalam Department has conducted a field visit to Kumaran Asan National Institute of Culture, Thonakkal on 5th September 2019. The aim of the field visit was to acquaint the students with the contributions of Kumaran Asan, who was one of the famous disciples of Sree Narayana Guru. While Sree Narayana Guru is honoured as the social reformer of Kerala, Kumaran Asan is credited with revolutionizing the Malayalam poetry in the beginning of the 20th century. Forty two students from our college participated in the field visit. The students visited the instituted where the house in which the poet lived is preserved and exhibited without any change. The museum containing the belongings of the poet along with the manuscripts of his renowned works made the students understand the life and development of the bard. The visit to the village lending library, the childrens' library, the research centre approved by the University of Kerala for language, literature, culture and history, the computer institute and the publishing and sales division at the Institute helped to instill the reading and research interest among the students.
